

# Sale High School Shoe Regulations

As of September 2016, in line with our continual drive to raise standards, the school is no longer allowing students to wear trainers to school and we ask that students wear smart school shoes.

Groupcall messages were sent to all parents and carers in July, prior to the summer holiday.

To clear up any confusion regarding what shoes we deem suitable, please see the guidance below.

**Whilst we appreciate that school shoes are expensive we ask that where shoes are deemed inappropriate, they are replaced as quickly as possible.**

## Guidance

1. Shoes must be black leather or patent
2. Boots are not permitted but 'shoe boots' like the Kickers style below are – the general rule is that shoes should be on or below the ankle bone
3. Shoes should not have the appearance of trainers as some Kickers and Converse shoes do

## Examples of permitted shoes:



Girls: Black leather lace-ups, slip-ons, slip-ons with straps

Boys: Black leather slip-ons, lace-ups, Velcro straps

## Examples of non-permitted shoes:



No over the ankle boots (including Ugg style boots), canvas pump styles, trainer styles, leather pumps
