Dear parents/carers,

I have a couple of important items to write home about.

Firstly, I am writing to let you know of changes to Covid 19 regulations following on from the Prime Minister's announcement.

- We will no longer be asking students to undertake the twice weekly Covid testing.
- Although there will no longer be a legal requirement to isolate the guidance is to be sensible. If your child is poorly, they should stay off school –in the same way that if they have any sickness- 'flu or a heavy cold.
- If your child has Covid, then please follow the guidelines that were previously given re self-isolation.
