Our collaboration with Sale Grammar continues into the Spring and Summer terms with new subject focuses. Some of our Year 8 and Year 9 Scholars also participated in a GCHQ outreach virtual language programme, enhancing their linguistic and analytical skills.

## **Spring Term**

Scholars are encouraged to participate in extracurricular clubs and keep an eye on Show My Homework/Satchel for updates on subject-specific competitions.

## **Summer Term**

As the year progresses, we'll continue with:

Subject Masterclasses and collaborations with Sale Grammar.

Model United Nations and/or Topic Talks sessions.

We're also excited to host a guest speaker, a doctor, who will talk about his journey into medicine and the impactful community and aid work he has undertaken in Africa. This inspiring session will give students a window into the importance of resilience, dedication, and service.

For our Year 10 and 11 Scholars, the Sale Scholars programme transitions into the Greater Manchester Higher Achievers Programme (GMHAP) in partnership with Loreto College. This includes:

- A-Level Taster Sessions to prepare for higher education.
- Subject Masterclasses to deepen subject expertise and explore career pathways.
  - Debate Events with other schools, sharpening critical thinking and public speaking skills.
