English Language and English Literature

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What you need to know



- You will leave Sale High School with 2 G.C.S.E's in English: English Language and English Literature.
- This is a core subject which means you have to do it.

In 2024:

76% of pupils achieved grades 4-9 in English Literature

70% achieved grades 4-9 in English Language

We are above the national averages for the whole country!

13% achieved grades 7-9 for English Literature

18% achieved grades 7-9 for English Language

The top grades are possible – but you need to work hard for them.

Exam: 100% exam.

2 exam papers. Both are 1 hour and 45 minutes long.

You will be given extracts of unseen texts and need to read, comment and analyse on the writers use of language and structure. You will be expected to write either a creative descriptive or narrative (story), and you will be expected to write either a: speech, letter or article.

There are no higher or foundation tiers. All pupils sit the same exams.

Coursework: None – BUT there is a "non-assessed" spoken language presentation ALL pupils have to complete as part of their G.C.S.E in English Language.

Crucial to know: if you do not achieve a grade 4 you HAVE to resit. Your grade for English Language is a grade all colleges/sixth forms expect you to pass whether you wish to study the subject or not.

Exam: 100% exam.

2 exam papers:

Paper 1: 'Macbeth' by William Shakespeare, and 'A Christmas Carol' by Charles Dickens. It is 1 hour 30 minutes.

Paper 2: 'An Inspector Calls' by J.B. Priestley, Power and Conflict poetry, Unseen poetry. It is 2 hours and 15 minutes.

You are expected to have your own copies of these set texts. School will provide them at a very good price and you can purchase them from Parent Pay in Year 10/11.

There are no higher or foundation tiers. All pupils sit the same exams.

Coursework: None.
