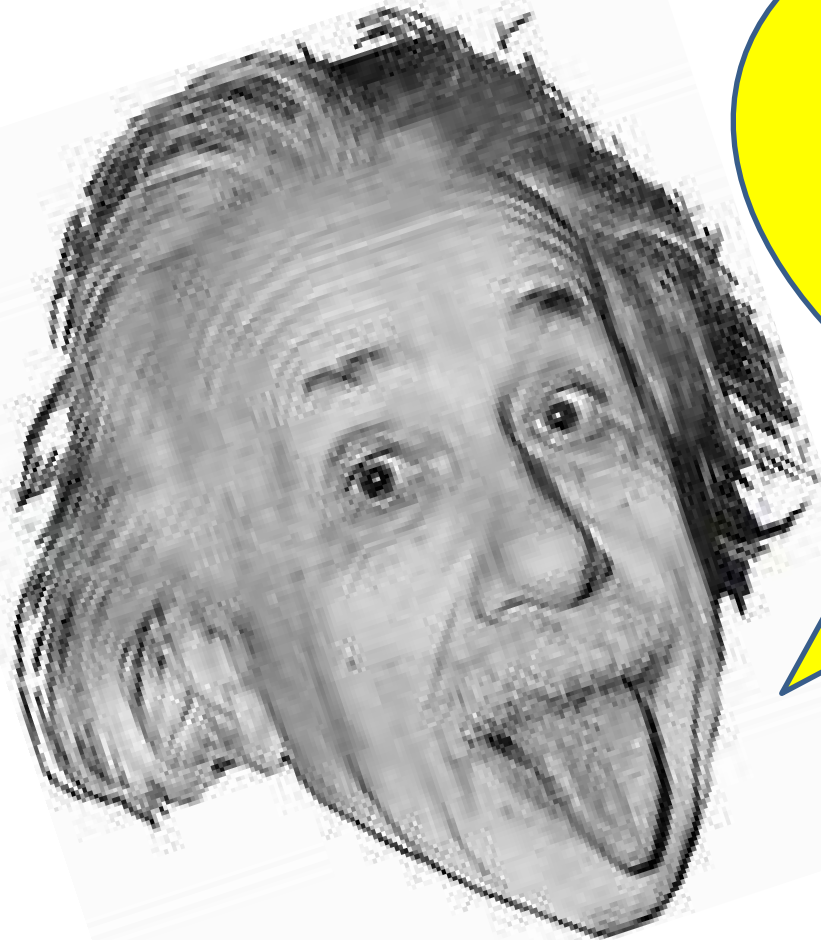

MUSIC
