

- If you are interested in a career in PE/Sport-PE teaching, sports coaching, sports lecturing, sports management, physiotherapy, sports nutrition & personal training.



Communications skills

Many aspects of PE involves working in teams towards a common goal. Through playing team sports and problem solving with others, <u>you'll develop clear communication skills that will help you in the workplace</u>. Every employer looks for candidates who are able to communicate well verbally and in writing.

Social skills

Physical education is a very social subject and can involve a lot of group work. You'll learn how communicate and <u>socialise</u> <u>with people in an effective way</u>. When you start working, you'll encounter people from a range of different backgrounds, each with different personalities. Studying PE will help you learn how to best communicate with people in a team in order to produce the best results.

Analysis and evaluation

At GCSE and A-Level, PE involves analysing your own and others' performance while looking for ways it could be improved. This is a particularly useful skill to have in your career as you'll often have to critique your own work and identify areas for improvement. If you work in management, you'll also benefit from the <u>soft skills</u> that PE teaches and will learn how to deliver messages clearly and effectively.
