### Do colleges prefer triple science over combine?

Colleges and sixth forms **will not require** you to have GCSEs in each separate science.

You need certain grade (combined or triple) to study a science A-level, however if you are wanting to do A-Level science Triple science will give you an advantage of additional content.

### Can I choose triple science?

If you want to take triple science, you must:

- Have a love of science
- Good track record of success in science
- Need to be working towards a 4 in maths and english

#### Is it hard?

Depends on who is asking! But most students think triple science is a hard GCSE.

You will need to be prepared for the workload: You will be receiving double the amount of homework and you will need to complete more revision for science.

### Will triple science give me an advantage after school?

You will find A level science easier as you have covered more content and will be better prepared. An increase in 1 grade of triple science gives a greater marginal effect then combined (aka, earning a higher grade in triple is correlated with earning more money compared to combined).
