FAQs

Q – Why should I take part?

A – Completing the Sale Award demonstrates you are a well-rounded, motivated 'SALE student' who's willing to take on new challenges and is someone who values their own personal development. Colleges and employers look for students who stand out and your involvement in the Sale Awards proves you have the confidence, skills and attitude to succeed beyond the classroom.

Q – How do I earn the Sale Award badge?

A – Complete 20 Sale award challenges (aim for 5 in each category), include evidence in a physical or online portfolio and show/email it to your form tutor once you think you've completed all 20

Q – What does my portfolio need to include?

A – Evidence of all the challenges you've completed. This can be a mixture of photos, form tutor/parental signatures and reflections and can be done on PowerPoint

Q – Do challenges completed in previous years carry over to this year? (Year 8-10)

A – Yes, if you're not sure how many challenges you're on in each category, ask your form tutor to display last year's Sale award spreadsheet or hand out last year's booklets if you still have them

FAQs

- Q I need help with my portfolio
- A Mr Brammall will be running a Sale Award club at lunchtime, look out for the extracurricular club timetable being released soon. This is also when bronze, silver and gold portfolio presentations can take place
- Q Can I tick off challenges I completed in the past?
- A Only challenges completed during your time at Sale High School will count
- Q I already achieved all 4 Sale badges, 25, 30, 40 or 50 badge last year, do I still need to start on the bronze award?
- A Depending on the quality of your portfolio and presentation of the values cards you complete, you may be awarded higher than the bronze award if you are in year 9/10.
- Q When will I get my Sale Award badge?
- A Once your form tutor has seen your portfolio, they'll sign the spreadsheet to say you deserve the badge and you'll receive it in the awards assembly at the end of the half term
