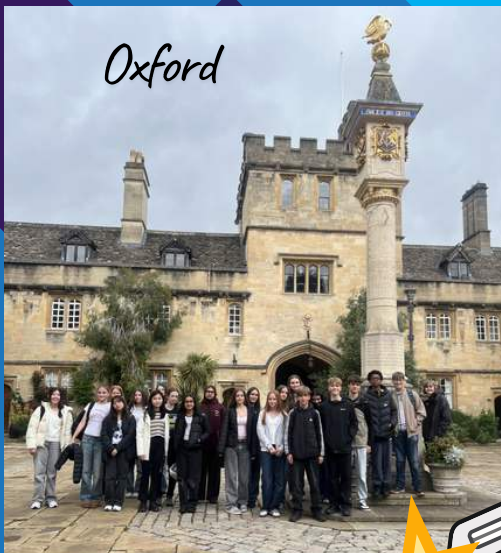


SALE SCHOLARS

This has been another successful year for the Scholars Programme, with students embracing a wide range of enriching opportunities designed to broaden their academic horizons and raise aspirations. All scholars participated in the University of Manchester Languages XP Masterclass, exploring the importance of languages in a global society and developing an understanding of the opportunities that language skills can unlock. Our in-house masterclasses have remained a key feature of the programme, enabling our expert teachers to share their subject knowledge through engaging lessons that extend beyond the demands of the school curriculum. Collaboration with Sale Grammar School and its sixth form students was another great success, providing scholars with valuable opportunities to learn from and work alongside older students. Visits to local universities have encouraged scholars to consider their future aspirations and gain a clearer understanding of the pathways available through further and higher education.

In addition, a small group of Year 9 scholars had the privilege of visiting Corpus Christi College, Oxford, where they gained an insight into the collegiate system and discovered that studying at Oxford is an achievable ambition for students from all backgrounds. A particular highlight of the year was the first Scholars residential trip to London for our Year 9 students. Scholars visited the British Museum, where they explored historical artefacts through a mathematical lens, before enjoying an engaging journey through the history of gaming at the Science Museum. The trip concluded with a visit to Bletchley Park, where students developed a deeper appreciation of the intelligence work, innovation, and sacrifice of the men and women whose efforts made a significant contribution to the Allied victory in the Second World War.
